

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

FRAMED WALL MIRRORS

Installing a framed wall mirror can add a touch of elegance and functionality to any space. Here are step-by-step installation instructions to guide you through the process:

Materials Needed:

Framed wall mirror

Pencil

Tape measure

Level

Wall anchors (if needed)
